History/Facts and Issues:

Wall Asphalt Services Inc., Franklin, GA: Total exp. \$372,175.00

Bid Ref. #26-005 was advertised in the Albany Herald, on the access channel, on our website, and posted to the Georgia Procurement Registry. This project is for repair, rejuvenation, and re-marking of taxiway A, B, C & E located at Southwest Georgia Regional Airport. The contract time of this project shall be a period of 73 days. 16 potential vendors were directly solicited, of which 7 are known to be minority and disadvantaged businesses. 8 vendors attended the pre-bid meeting, and 4 bids were received with Wall Asphalt Services Inc. being the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Options/Pros and Cons:

Pros:

- The repair, rejuvenation, and re-marking are part of normal maintenance that extends the life of the taxiway and keeps the Airport in FAA compliance.

Con:

- Construction may cause temporary delay of Airport traffic.

Recommended Action:

Approval.

25% Airport Fund (\$93,043.75)
