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**History/Facts and Issues:**

The Georgia Department of Transportation facilitated the widening of Ledo Road prior to the delegation of maintenance responsibility to the City of Albany and Lee County. The Parties desire to cooperate in the resurfacing of Ledo Road (U.S. 82 to U.S. 19), which crosses both jurisdictions. The "Project" consists of milling, patching, resurfacing, striping, and related improvements to 3.48 miles of Ledo Road, including traffic signal loop adjustments and shoulder grading. Shared Line Items: Mobilization, Bonding and Insurance, Traffic Control, and Striping shall be divided between approximately 74.57% Lee County and approximately 25.43% Albany. Current estimates place the combined project cost at approximately \$1,986,610, of which Lee County's share is approximately \$1,481,420 and Albany's share is approximately \$505,190. To expedite starting work on this project, Lee County will issue the Invitation to Bid based on a Memorandum of Understanding. A formal Intergovernmental Agreement will be submitted for approval by the Mayor and Commissioners following receipt of validated bids and a recommendation for issuing a Notice of Award.

**Options/Pros and Cons:**

Pro:

- A coordinated project will provide efficiency in construction, consistency in roadway quality, and cost savings to taxpayers.

Con:

- Temporary traffic disruption and/or delays due to construction.

**Recommended Action:**

Adopt authorizing resolution
